

FAQ's

- Q How long is a Stacatruc Apprenticeship?
- A The Stacatruc Apprenticeship is 3 years.
- Q What will I learn during the apprenticeship?

A You will learn how to inspect, maintain, service and repair all types of materials handling equipment

including forklift trucks and warehouse equipment.

Q What qualifications are required to apply for an apprenticeship?

A Apprentice technicians require 5 GCSE's including Math's and English, as well as interest in electrics and mechanics.

Q What qualification will be gained on completion of the apprenticeship?

A Successful candidates will gain a Lift truck and powered access engineering technician - level 3 qualification.

- Q Once I have finished my apprenticeship, will I be offered a permanent role?
- A The majority of successful Stacatruc apprentices will be offered a permanent role within Stacatruc.
